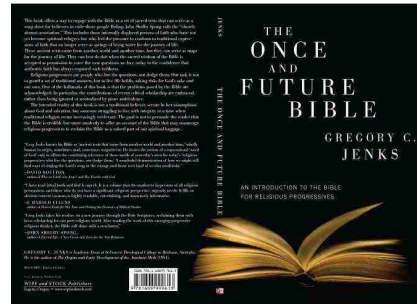
THE ONCE AND FUTURE BIBLE
