

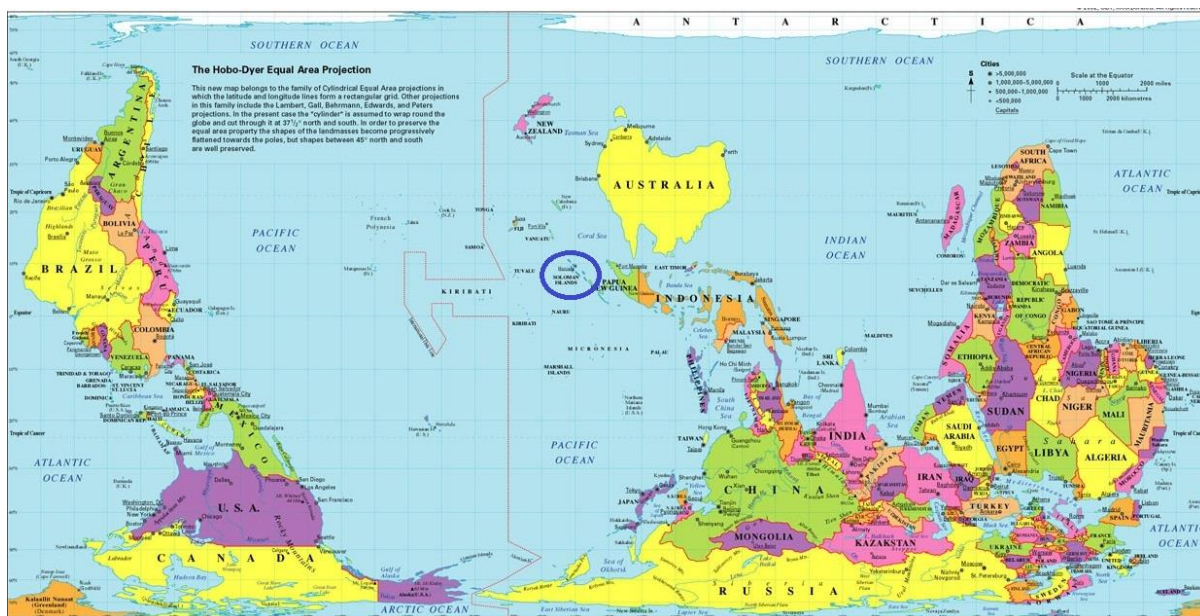
PRESENTATIONS AND PRAYERS
